Proposals for papers dealing with the legacy of St. Constantine-Cyril, the Apostle of the Slavs, its manifestations in the oldest written Slavic language, literature and culture of Great Moravia, as well as papers on the medieval reception and reflection of his work and personage, are welcome.

The papers will be considered for publication in a thematic issue of the international peer-reviewed journal *Slavia*.

The length of the presentation is 15 minutes. Attending the conference is free of charge. Travel and accommodation expenses will be covered by each participant.
